

FASHION SHOWS

Contemporary yet Classic.

For FW25 at Copenhagen Fashion Week rich, deep tones dominated, with earthy browns, midnight blues, and deep reds grounding the season's palette, while pops of vibrant hues added energy. Plains dominated but prints leaned towards florals, animalier and plaids, offering a classic touch. Fabric choices played a crucial role in shaping silhouettes, with full denim looks leading the way, alongside plush furry textiles, shearling, and structured suede and leather. Satin and velvets introduced softness and fluidity, balancing the season's heavier materials. Meanwhile, sheer fabrics declined, used sparingly for layering rather than as focal points. This interplay of color, print, and texture defined FW25, blending durability with luxury for a contemporary, tactile aesthetic.

WOMENSWEAR COPENHAGEN COLORS

The FW25 womenswear collections at Copenhagen Fashion Week embraced a refined and understated color palette, dominated by neutral tones and monochrome aesthetics. Leading the runway were soft, muted hues of beige, white, and grey, setting a tone of quiet luxury and effortless elegance. These classic shades reinforced the season's preference for minimalist, plain silhouettes, creating a clean and modern look.

Adding depth and richness, designers incorporated sophisticated fall shades like burgundy, plum, and deep wood, injecting warmth and a sense of timeless opulence into the collections. These darker hues provided striking contrasts against the otherwise neutral backdrop, giving an air of understated drama.

A key color trend was the presence of swampy khakis, ranging from deep, earthy greens to lighter olive tones. These shades felt natural and grounded, seamlessly integrating into the season's monochrome ensembles. Whether used in structured tailoring or fluid drapery, khaki tones added an organic, utilitarian touch to the collections.

WOMENSWEAR COPENHAGEN PRINTS & PATTERNS

At Copenhagen Fashion Week Fall/Winter 2025, designers showcased a diverse array of prints that balanced tradition with modernity. Plaids with a heritage vibe were prominent, as seen in Baum und Pferdgarten's collection, which featured plaid bubble skirts that added a contemporary twist to classic patterns.

Animal prints made a significant impact, with leopard and zebra patterns taking center stage. Attendees embraced these bold designs, incorporating them into their ensembles to create vibrant street styles. Florals were reimagined with a macro approach, offering a fresh perspective on traditional motifs. Marimekko delved into its archives to present vibrant, large-scale flower prints, infusing the runway with bold and colorful displays.



WOMENSWEAR COPENHAGEN TEXTILES

The FW25 womenswear collections at Copenhagen Fashion Week embraced bold fabric choices, blending durability with soft opulence. Full denim silhouettes dominated, reimagined beyond casual-wear into structured tailoring, oversized layering, and sculptural shapes.

Furry textiles and shearling introduced warmth and volume, elevating outerwear, oversized scarves, and statement accessories with a sense of tactile luxury. Suede and leather made a strong impact, bringing richness and depth to sleek outerwear, fitted dresses, and sculptural separates, reinforcing an air of understated elegance.

Satin and velvets softened the season's aesthetic, adding sensuality with their fluid drape and rich textures. Meanwhile, sheer materials, once a mainstay, saw a decline, used more sparingly in layering rather than as a focal point.

This season's fabric choices reflected a shift toward textural contrasts—rugged denim and structured leather juxtaposed against plush furs and fluid satins.


